OCWTP programs designated as approved for licensure credit hours can be used by licensees toward license renewal requirements. 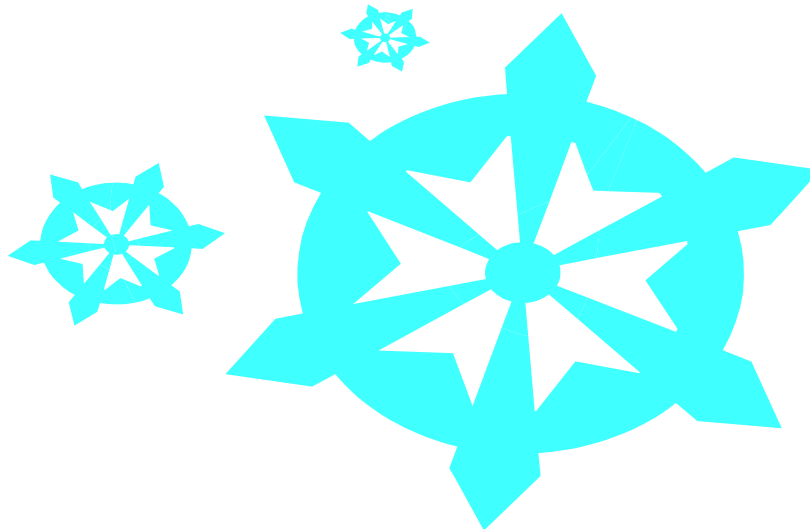

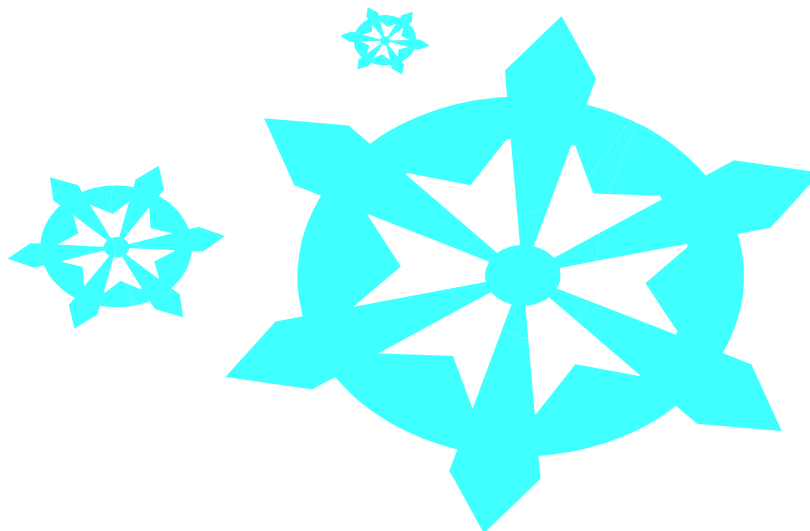

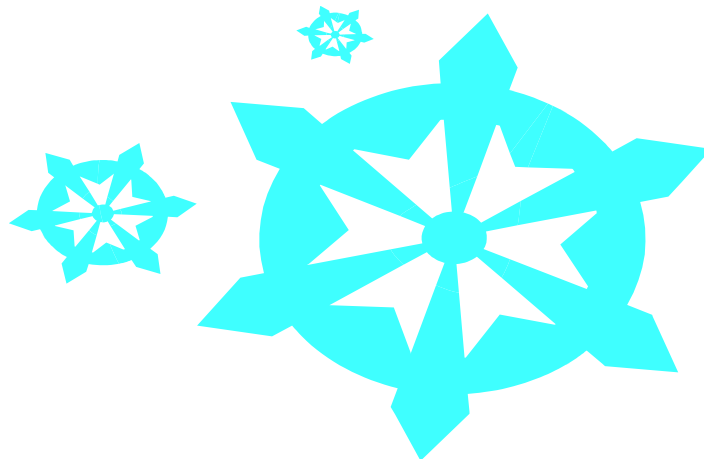
